

**KITSAP COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**March 6, 2007**

The meeting was called to order at 11:20 a.m.

**MINUTES**

The minutes for the January 9, 2007, and February 6, 2007, meetings were approved as circulated.

**DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Dr. Lindquist introduced Peter House, University of Washington Associate Professor in the School of Health Services and Family Medicine. Mr. House explained to the Board that he is an advisor in the Community Health-Oriented Public Health Practice program at the University of Washington. As part of its curriculum, students in this program explore case-based problem solving in the field. Mr. House told the Board that Dr. Lindquist has invited students in his program to conduct a field survey in several Kitsap County locations to evaluate community perceptions of attitudes towards public health needs. A discussion followed with Board members expressing approval of this initiative.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION PURSUANT TO RCW 42.30.110(1)(i) TO DISCUSS POTENTIAL LITIGATION**

The Board recessed at 11:40 pursuant to RCW 42.20.110(1)(i) to discuss potential litigation. The Board reconvened at 11:53.

**RESOLUTION 2007-4 APPROVAL OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH FEES**

Jerry Deeter, Director of Environmental Health, addressed the Board regarding issues raised in the January 2007 Board meeting with regard to the 2007 Environmental Fee Schedule. After some discussion, Mayor Kordonowy moved and Council Member Snow seconded the motion to approve Resolution 2007-4. The motion passed unanimously.

**ONSITE SEWAGE REGULATIONS OVERVIEW**

Jerry Deeter, Director of Environmental Health, along with Keith Grellner, Deputy Director of Environmental Health, walked the Board through an overview of changes to the on-site waste water treatment laws that will require more oversight and inspections for all septic systems. Both commented that this is an introduction to the rule changes and that more information will be presented at future board meetings.
